Fly of the Month - The Peacock and Partridge




There are thousands of fly patterns out there, but the ones that stick around are the ones that actually catch fish. One such pattern is the Peacock and Partridge. The P&P is a traditional wet fly that was probably first tied on the English chalk streams hundreds of years ago. Wet flies in general have fallen out of favor, having been replaced by Dry/Nymph/Streamer patterns. The fly shown here varies slightly from the original pattern (gold braid instead of wire, and a hot pink fluorescent thread tag instead of the traditional red tag), but other than that it's pretty much the same. This soft hackle fly will work on trout and panfish, and can be used on lakes and ponds as well as streams.

Hook: Wet fly/Nymph sizes 12 - 16, Tag: Hot Pink Thread, Rib: Small Gold Braid,

Body: 2 or 3 strands of Peacock Herl, Soft Hackle: Hungarian Partridge

Trout Fishing on Long Island's Spring Creeks

The other day I picked up a copy of Trout Fishing on Long Island S Spring Creeks at River Bay Outfitters. This is the third edition of the guide, and like the previous two, is brought to us by the Long Island Chapter of Trout Unlimited. I cantisay enough good things about this book. The Authors have updated and rewritten about 90% of the text from the previous versions, and have added links to websites and maps to bring us a comprehensive publication that not only lists places to fish, but in some cases even includes pool by pool descriptions within these places. The Carlls River, and Massapequa Creek, as well as the White's Pool area of the Nissequogue and Rattlesnake creek of the Connetquot (not in the previous editions) have been added to this edition. Interesting historical info is woven into the individual sections, and a list of Flies has been revised to reflect the current popular ones. Chapters on Catch and Release, and Stream Etiquette round out the guide.



Peter Dubno Jr., Tom McCoy, Joe Ordierna, Luke Baranov, and Boyd Shockley are the LITU Committee Members responsible for the book. This clearly was a labor of love for this group.

Peter and Tom will be giving a presentation on Long Island Spring Creeks at the Long Island Fly Fishing Exposition on March 17th. As the title suggests, this book primarily deals with Trout Fishing. If you would like to know more about Bass Fishing on LI, plan on attending Lee Weil presentation at the LIFFE. Check the LIFFE website (www.LIFFExpo.com) for details.

The book is available at the above mentioned River Bay Outfitters, Campsite, Terminal Tackle, and at LITU Meetings for \$12. You can also get the book by mail by sending a \$15 check made out to LITU, c/o Tom Loproto, 68 Murray Dr., Westbury, NY 11590. Be sure to include your address.

If you ve ever asked Where can I fish for trout on Long Island? — this is the book for you!









If you are not a business and you have a bag of line, send it to the following address. Remember that birds and marine animals become entangled in fishing line. Do what you can. Make sure the line is clean of debris, hooks, and metal attachments.






